Families:

Due to the increase in sickness and the overall sickness in the area, we are updating our sickness and quarantining policy:

- Please monitor your child's health each morning and do NOT send your child to school with any symptoms of a cold, Covid, or the flu.
- We will be implementing a 72 hours fever-free and symptom-free policy. If your child develops symptoms while in our care you will be notified to come and pick them up right away.
- Like many licensed and in-home daycares, we will be continuing to require a 14 day quarantine for children in our facility that have been exposed to COVID.
- Due to conflicts, we will no longer be able to waive tuition for positive tests that do not come from within the facility.
- If your child is quarantined from a positive test within the center, tuition will be waived.
- If you have someone with symptoms of sickness (RSV, flu, stomach virus, COVID, etc) in your home please refrain from sending your child to the center.

We are doing our best to remain open, please help us with these efforts. We realize everyone is struggling right now with sickness and employment, we are also dealing with similar issues. The more we can work together to keep our kids and staff healthy, the more likely we will be able to remain open and provide care.
